2013 Wisconsin Act 113
[2013 Senate Bill 333]

Transitional Jobs Program

Under **current law**, the Department of Children and Families (DCF) is required to establish a program, known as the Transform Milwaukee Jobs Program, offering subsidized employment opportunities to certain low-income residents of Milwaukee County transitioning to unsubsidized employment.

2013 Wisconsin Act 113 authorizes DCF to establish a Transitional Jobs program, with the same eligibility and program requirements as the Transform Milwaukee Jobs Program, outside of Milwaukee County, to the extent of available funds. In selecting the geographic area or areas in which to conduct the Transitional Jobs program, DCF must give priority to those areas with relatively high rates of unemployment and childhood poverty.

Effective date: The Act took effect on December 20, 2013.
