



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 232
[2013 Assembly Bill 368]

**Purchases or Transfers of Rifles or
Shotguns in Other States**

Wisconsin law allows a resident of Wisconsin or an entity maintaining a place of business in Wisconsin to obtain a rifle or shotgun in a state that is contiguous to Wisconsin if the transfer complies with federal law and the laws of both states.

2013 Wisconsin Act 232 specifies that a resident of Wisconsin or an entity maintaining a place of business in Wisconsin may obtain a rifle or shotgun in a state that is not contiguous to Wisconsin if the transfer complies with federal law and the laws of both states.

Effective date: The Act took effect on April 10, 2014.
