



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 255
[2013 Senate Bill 271]

State Special Education Aid

Under current law, a school district, cooperative educational service agency (CESA), or county may receive state special education aid for the costs of contracting with private or public agencies for various services including physical or occupational therapy services, educational interpreter services, and speech and language therapy.

Act 255 specifies that a school district, CESA, or county may also receive special education aid for the cost of contracting with private or public agencies for substitute teaching and paraprofessional staffing services.

Effective date: Act 255 takes effect on April 10, 2014, and first applies to state aid paid in the 2014-15 school year.
