

## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

## 2013 Wisconsin Act 268 [2013 Senate Bill 250]

**Temporary Alcohol Beverage Retail Licenses Issued to Fair Associations** 

Wisconsin law authorizes municipalities to issue temporary licenses to certain organizations that authorize the retail sale of beer and wine at fairs, meetings, picnics, and similar gatherings. In general, a licensee may not provide taste samples unless there is a person who is responsible for the acts of all persons selling or serving any intoxicating liquor to customers. **2013 Wisconsin Act 268** creates an exception to that requirement when a municipality issues a temporary license to a fair association solely for the purpose of conducting beer or wine judging or tasting events if the tasting involves servings no greater than one fluid ounce each.

*Effective date and initial applicability:* The Act took effect on April 18, 2014 and first applies to licenses issued on that day.
