

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2013 Wisconsin Act 370 [2013 Senate Bill 269] Moped Dealer and Recreational Vehicle Dealer Requirements

Wisconsin law prohibits engaging in the business of selling recreational vehicles or mopeds unless licensed to do so by the Department of Transportation. Under **prior law**, any person who violated this law was required to be fined between \$25 and \$100. Under **2013 Wisconsin Act 370**, a person who violates this law may be required to forfeit between \$25 and \$100 for a first offense and may be subject to a fine between \$25 and \$100 for a second or subsequent violation within three years.

Effective date and initial applicability: The Act took effect on April 25, 2014, and first applies to violations committed on that date, but does not preclude the counting of other violations as prior violations for purposes of sentencing a person.
