

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AMENDMENT MEMO

2013 Assembly Bill 234	Assembly Amendment 1

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) is required to publish highway service maps showing the state trunk highway system, and folded highway maps of the state. DOT must identify, on these maps, each veterans memorial highway or bridge, and the location of specified veterans memorials, homes, and museums.

2013 Assembly Bill 234 requires DOT to include on these maps identification of the location of the Wisconsin Veterans Tribute in the Village of Cadott. **Assembly Amendment 1** to Assembly Bill 234 requires DOT to also include the Citizen Soldier Monument, also in the Village of Cadott.

Bill History

Representative Larson offered Assembly Amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 234 on March 5, 2014. On March 11, 2014, the Assembly Committee on Transportation voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 0; and passage of Assembly Bill 234, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes, 0.
