2013 Assembly Bill 341 allows counties and municipalities to certify, to the Department of Revenue (DOR) for collection, debts of \$20 or more owed to an ambulance service operating pursuant to a contract with the county or municipality, if the debt relates to providing ambulance services to individuals in that municipality or county. Under the bill, DOR may collect the debt for the county or municipality by subtracting the amount of the debt from any tax refund owed to the debtor.

Assembly Amendment 1 provides that, in order for an amount to be considered a “debt” subject to the procedure under the bill, the debt must be reduced to a judgment or the ambulance service provider must receive written acknowledgment from the debtor of the debt owed.

Bill History

On February 5, 2014, the Assembly Committee on State and Local Finance voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on votes of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0, and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 6; Noes, 2.
