2013 Assembly Bill 348	Assembly Amendment 1

2013 Assembly Bill 348 (“the bill”) explicitly authorizes a school district, county, and cooperative educational service agency (CESA) to contract for substitute teaching and paraprofessional staffing services, and makes the costs of such a contract eligible for special education aid. If enacted, the bill would go into effect the day after publication.

Assembly Amendment 1 to 2013 Assembly Bill 348 (“the amendment”) delays the effect of the bill. Under the amendment, the bill first applies to state aid paid in the 2014-15 fiscal year.

Bill History

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Kestell. On October 3, 2013, the Assembly Committee on Education recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 348, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 8; Noes, 0.
