2013 Assembly Bill 426 establishes an authorized special group enumerated in state law for persons interested in obtaining registration plates honoring this state's support of the U.S. Olympic Committee. The bill provides that the Department of Transportation (DOT) shall commence development work on these plates once it has received contributions totaling an amount equal to its final estimate of the initial costs of production of the plates or \$11,800, whichever is less. **Assembly Amendment 1** to Assembly Bill 426 provides that DOT shall commence development work once it has received contributions totaling an amount equal to its final estimate of the initial costs of production of the plates or \$23,700, whichever is less.

Bill History

Representative Bewley offered Assembly Amendment 1 to Assembly Bill 426 on February 24, 2014. On March 11, 2014, the Assembly Committee on Transportation voted to recommend adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 1; and passage of Assembly Bill 426, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 14; Noes, 0.
