2013 Assembly Bill 456

Assembly Bill 456 requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to promulgate rules by January 1, 2016, to create a mechanism for counties to report which mental health services and programs they provide.

<u>Assembly Amendment 1</u>

Assembly Amendment 1 replaces the provisions of the bill with the requirement that DHS provide a report to the Legislature that describes the mental health services and programs provided by counties and regions comprised of multiple counties. DHS must provide the report to the Legislature on January 1, 2015, and January 1 of every odd-numbered year thereafter.

<u>Bill History</u>

Representative Ballweg offered Assembly Amendment 1 on October 28, 2013. On November 5, 2013, the Assembly Committee on Health voted to recommend adoption of the amendment, and passage of the bill as amended, on successive votes of Ayes, 9; Noes, 0.
