**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 8,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 191**

May 5, 2015 – Offered by Representatives JORGENSEN, GOYKE, KOLSTE, SPREITZER  
and SUBECK.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 18: after that line insert:

3 “(7) After at least 100 individuals in the 3 programs specified in sub. (1) (c) 1.  
4 to 3. in the aggregate have undergone testing for the use of a controlled substance,  
5 the department shall discontinue the screening, testing, and treatment  
6 requirements under this section at any point at which less than 1 percent of all of  
7 those who have been tested have a test result that is positive for the use of a  
8 controlled substance without presenting evidence of a valid prescription for the  
9 controlled substance.”.

10 **2.** Page 8, line 17: after that line insert:

11 “e. After at least 100 individuals in the program specified in this subdivision  
12 have undergone testing for the use of a controlled substance, the department shall  
13 discontinue the screening, testing, and treatment requirements under this

1 paragraph at any point at which less than 1 percent of all of those who have been  
2 tested have a test result that is positive for the use of a controlled substance without  
3 presenting evidence of a valid prescription for the controlled substance.”.
