Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-318 removes the need to qualify a week prior to receiving the first payment of Unemployment Insurance benefits.

This estimate assumes that the removal of the one week waiting period requires one-time changes needing 87 hours of IT staff time and 47 of administrative staff time to complete database changes and run quality control measures. The estimated total one-time cost is \$9,900.

The repeal of the one week waiting period is expected reduce the UI trust fund balance by \$24.6 million annually due to an increase in claimant benefit outlays and corresponding increase UI tax revenue.
