AN ACT to create 86.35 of the statutes; relating to: requiring approval by a municipal governing body before construction of highway roundabouts.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, no roundabout may be constructed as part of a highway project unless the authority in charge of the highway project obtains approval for the roundabout from the governing body of the municipality where the proposed roundabout would be located.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 86.35 of the statutes is created to read:

86.35 Approval of municipal governing body required before construction of roundabouts. (1) In this section, "municipality" means a city, village, or town.
