



2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 531

November 18, 2015 – Introduced by Representatives TRANEL, NOVAK, E. BROOKS, JARCHOW, TITTL and STEFFEN, cosponsored by Senators MARKLEIN and MOULTON. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 347.25 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** lighting on vehicles in
2 a funeral procession.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the lead vehicle in a funeral procession may be equipped with a flashing amber light. Any vehicle in the procession may also be equipped with a flashing amber light if all vehicles in the procession are so equipped. A vehicle equipped with such a light may only use the light in the procession. Under this bill, vehicles permitted to be equipped with a flashing amber light may instead be equipped with a flashing purple light.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 347.25 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 347.25 (3) The lead vehicle in a funeral procession may be equipped, or any
5 vehicle in the procession may be equipped if all vehicles in the procession are so
6 equipped, with a flashing amber or purple light that may be used only in the
7 procession.
