

1 **AN ACT** to create 118.43 (2) (bu) of the statutes; **relating to:** one-year extension of
2 student achievement guarantee in education program contracts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

JOINT LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL PREFATORY NOTE: This bill draft was prepared for the Joint Legislative Council's Study Committee on Student Achievement Guarantee in Education (SAGE) Program.

SAGE is a categorical state aid program that provides funding to schools for low-income students in primary grades (K-3) if certain statutory requirements are met. Before a school may participate in SAGE, the school board of the district must enter into a contract with the department of public instruction (DPI) on behalf of individual schools in the district that qualify for participation. SAGE contracts are for 5 years and may be renewed for additional 5-year terms.

This draft allows DPI to provide a one-year extension on existing SAGE contracts set to expire at the end of the current 2014-15 school year. The draft also prohibits DPI from renewing contracts expiring at the end of this 2014-15 school year.

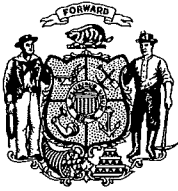

Without an extension, the 354 SAGE contracts set to expire at the end of the current 2014-15 school year will likely be renewed before legislation changing the SAGE program is enacted. 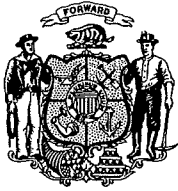
