Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Commercial (for-profit) driver training schools (driver schools) and instructors are licensed and regulated by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT), and are currently required to provide instruction at a facility (classroom) used to conduct driver training. This bill would allow these particular driver schools to also provide instruction by means of the Internet (online) instead of, or in addition to, providing instruction in a classroom.

This bill would require DOT's Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to make some minor modifications to its existing manuals, procedures and administrative rules. In addition, it is also anticipated that the number of driver school applications requiring review and approval by DOT would increase. The department estimates that this bill will result in increased administrative costs in the amount of approximately \$28,100, which include the cost of an additional 0.5 FTE.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
