Hi Eric,

Sen. Fitzgerald would like to get a bill drafted:

Current statute (Wis. Stat. §347.07(2)) prohibits undercarriage lighting on motor vehicles.

Sen. Fitzgerald would like to amend this statute to allow for limited undercarriage lighting. The state of Kansas allows this now, and he would like a bill drafted to incorporate similar language into the Wisconsin statutes. The current Kansas statute is 8-1723(f), which reads as follows:

- "(f) Any motor vehicle may be equipped with neon ground effect lighting, except that such lighting shall not flash, be any shade of red nor shall any portion of the neon tubes be visible. "Neon ground effect lighting" means neon tubes placed underneath the motor vehicle for the purpose of illuminating the ground below the motor vehicle creating a halo light effect."

The intent would be to modify Wisconsin law to allow for lighting (not necessarily just neon tubes) that does not flash, does not conflict with emergency light colors, and where the light tube itself is not visible.

There is no rush on this request.
