This draft provides that, if the Department of Natural Resources issues a special carcass tag with deer hunting licenses issued to persons under the age of 18 and the carcass tag allows that person to hunt an antlerless deer, then the group hunting provisions under s. 29.324 do not allow another member of the group deer hunting party to use that antlerless deer tag.

The draft does not refer to zero quota zones because it is my understanding that there is really no way for a hunter to know if the hunter is in a zero quota zone. That is, DNR sets quotas for the purpose of determining how many tags to issue but that information is not generally available to the hunting public. Please let me know if the draft in its current form meets your intent.
