Senator Moulton is concerned that during special youth hunts (where youth can take antlerless deer in a buck-only zone), youth are driving deer and the accompanying adult will shoot the deer and are then authorized to use the youth's tag under 29.324 (Group Hunting). Senator Moulton is hoping for a preliminary draft of a bill that would outlaw "group hunting" as defined under 29.324 during these special youth hunts. The idea is that this would keep the actual hunting done by youth and preserve youth hunts. Is that something one of you might be able to help me with, or can you refer me to the appropriate person? Any advisement would be greatly appreciated.

Thank you so much for your draft related to the youth hunt. Unfortunately my instructions didn't quite hit the mark. Could I get another preliminary draft that includes these two things:

1. There does not need to be any reference to the youth hunt, as only youth can hunt.
2. What I want to get at is this: Where there is a zero quota for antlerless harvest during the nine day regular gun deer season, but youth 17 and under may harvest an antlerless deer in a zero quota zone, that no group hunting would be allowed. Meaning that, no adults could kill a antlerless deer and have a youth 17 and under tag it.

Hope that makes sense and thanks again for your help,
