Thank you so much for your draft related to the youth hunt. Unfortunately my instructions didn't quite hit the mark. Could I get another preliminary draft that includes these two things:

- 1. There does not need to be any reference to the youth hunt, as only youth can hunt.
- 2. What I want to get at is this: Where there is a zero quota for antierless harvest during the nine day regular gun deer season, but youth 17 and under may harvest an antlerless deer in a zero quota zone, that no group hunting would be allowed. Meaning that, no adults could kill a antierless deer and have a youth 17 and under tag it.

Hope that makes sense and thanks again for your help.

INSERT ANALYSIS B
