2015 BILL

1 AN ACT to amend 346.37 (1) (b) and 346.39 (2); and to create 346.37 (1) (e) of
2 the statutes; relating to: flashing yellow arrow traffic control signals.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, vehicular traffic facing a yellow traffic control signal must stop before entering the intersection unless the stop cannot be made safely. However, vehicular traffic facing a flashing yellow traffic control signal may enter the intersection with caution.

This bill clarifies that vehicular traffic facing a flashing yellow arrow traffic control signal may enter the intersection without stopping after yielding to other traffic lawfully in the intersection.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 346.37 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 346.37 (1) (b) *Yellow*. When Except as provided in par. (e) and s. 346.39 (2),
5 when shown with or following the green, traffic facing a yellow signal shall stop
6 before entering the intersection unless so close to it that a stop may not be made in
7 safety.
