Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill provides that no additional approval or fee is needed for the owner of an approved high capacity well to repair or maintain the well; to construct a replacement high capacity well of substantially the same depth within a 75-foot radius of the existing high capacity well; to reconstruct the existing high capacity well; or to transfer the approval at the same time as the owner transfers the land on which the approved high capacity well is located.

Fiscal Impact:

The department estimates that the costs associated with implementing this bill will be negligible.

Revenue: The department estimates that this bill will decrease revenue by \$5,000 per year. This decreased revenue is associated with an estimated 10 high capacity well actions that will no longer be subject to a \$500 application review fee.
