SUBJECT: Technical Memorandum on Senate Bill 273, relating to: state payments for municipal services

The department has the following concerns with the bill.

- 1. The bill does not change 20.835(5)(a) to a sum sufficient appropriation. The Department of Administration could not implement the bill with the current sum certain (annual) appropriation. The Department recommends changing 20.835(5)(a) to a sum sufficient.
 - a. 20.835(5)(a) Payments for municipal services. The amounts in the schedule A sum sufficient to make payments for municipal services provided by municipalities to state facilities, as determined under s. 70.119 (7).
- 2. The bill is essentially replacing the proration provided under current law s.70.119(7)(a), but the bill does not delete the proration. The Department recommends deleting the current law proration:
 - a. The department shall make payment from the appropriation under s. 20.835 (5) (a) for municipal services provided by municipalities to state facilities. If the appropriation under s. 20.835 (5) (a) is insufficient to pay the full amount under sub. (6) in any one year, the department shall prorate payments among the municipalities entitled thereto. The University of Wisconsin Hospitals and Clinics Authority shall make payment for municipal services provided by municipalities to facilities of the authority described in s. 70.11 (38).
