Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law provides DOT's Division of State Patrol with the authority to promulgate rules regulating the safety of interstate motor carrier operations, including rules implementing federal motor carrier safety standards. This bill simply extends the existing regulations that apply to for-hire motor carriers operating in interstate commerce to motor carriers also engaged in intrastate commerce.
