## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The Wisconsin Veterans Employment Initiative, a program to increase the number of veterans holding permanent state government positions, creates a Council on Veterans Employment to advise and assist the governor and state agencies with the recruitment and employment of veterans. Under this bill, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) provides staff support for the council. DWD assumes the staff support for the council would include providing employment data to be used by each state agency to calculate a veteran employment goal using the ratio set forth in the bill. To obtain the necessary data, DWD would use data from the ETA 9002 B Labor Exchange Reporting System referred to as the Job Center of Wisconsin (JCW) system. In this data, the number of veterans registered in the JCW system would be provided. The JCW data relies on veterans who have registered in the JCW system and would not include those who did not register. The department assumes there will be a nominal fee for data extract, however, the total cost is indeterminate and likely to be able to be absorbed by the department.
