This bill adds one additional circuit court branch for Calumet, Wood, Marathon, Dunn, and Polk counties, effective August 1, 2016, and one additional circuit court branch for Jackson and Vilas counties, effective August 1, 2017.

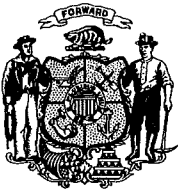

SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.

(1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the Director of State Courts and Law Library under section 20.680 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2015, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2016-17 is increased by \$12,000 to establish a law library for each circuit court judge in the state.
