1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 1, line 4: delete the material beginning with "Trail" and ending with  
3 "appropriation" on line 5 and substitute "Trail". ✓

4 2. Page 1, line 6: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
5 page 3, line 4. ✓

6 3. Page 3, line 10: delete "I 94 enters Wisconsin and" and substitute "STH 31  
7 enters Wisconsin; turning onto and proceeding on STH 165 west; entering I 94 and  
8 then". ✓

9 4. Page 3, line 21: delete "The" and substitute "Subject to sub. (3), the". ✓

10 5. Page 4, line 19: delete lines 19 to 22 and substitute: ✓

11 "(3) (a) Subject to par. (b), upon receipt of sufficient contributions from  
12 interested parties, including any county, municipality, state agency other than the

1 department, or federal agency, to cover the costs of fabricating, erecting, and  
2 maintaining markers along the route specified in sub. (1) to identify to motorists the  
3 designation of the route as the “Frank Lloyd Wright Trail” and the location of  
4 buildings designed or constructed by Frank Lloyd Wright that are open to the public  
5 and that are within 15 miles of the route specified in sub. (1), the department shall  
6 erect and maintain the markers.

7 (b) 1. Except as provided in subd. 2., the department may not encumber or  
8 expend any state funds from any appropriation to the department under s. 20.395  
9 for the costs of fabrication, erection, maintenance, or replacement of markers  
10 identified in par. (a).

11 2. The department may encumber or expend funds received as contributions  
12 to cover the costs of fabrication, erection, maintenance, or replacement of markers  
13 identified in par. (a) that may include funds received from another state agency for  
14 this purpose.

15 3. The department may not encumber or expend any federal funds from any  
16 appropriation to the department under s. 20.395 for the costs of fabrication, erection,  
17 maintenance, or replacement of markers identified in par. (a) except federal funds  
18 expressly allocated by federal law or by the applicable federal agency for the markers  
19 identified in par. (a).”.

20 **6.** Page 5, line 3: after that line insert: ✓

21 **“SECTION 6m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

22 (1) The department of transportation shall determine the dollar amount  
23 necessary to fabricate and erect the signs required under section 84.10255 of the  
24 statutes, as created by this act, and report the amount to the department of tourism.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete the material beginning with “Trail” and ending with  
3 “appropriation” on line 5 and substitute “Trail”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 6: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
5 page 3, line 4, and substitute:

6 “SECTION 2m. 41.11 (1) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 41.11 (1) (h) Annually report to the senate natural resources committee and  
8 the assembly committee on tourism the activities, marketing efforts, receipts, and  
9 disbursements of the department for the previous fiscal year. The report under this  
10 paragraph shall include information on the marketing efforts conducted for the  
11 Frank Lloyd Wright Trail established under s. 84.10255.”.

1           **3.** Page 3, line 10: delete “I 94 enters Wisconsin and” and substitute “STH 31  
2 enters Wisconsin; turning onto and proceeding on STH 165 west; entering I 94 and  
3 then”.

4           **4.** Page 3, line 21: delete “The” and substitute “Subject to sub. (3), the”.

5           **5.** Page 4, line 19: delete lines 19 to 22 and substitute:

6           “(3) (a) Subject to par. (b), upon receipt of sufficient contributions from  
7 interested parties, including any county, municipality, state agency other than the  
8 department, or federal agency, to cover the costs of fabricating, erecting, and  
9 maintaining markers along the route specified in sub. (1) to identify to motorists the  
10 designation of the route as the “Frank Lloyd Wright Trail” and the location of  
11 buildings designed or constructed by Frank Lloyd Wright that are open to the public  
12 and that are within 15 miles of the route specified in sub. (1), the department shall  
13 erect and maintain the markers.

14           (b) 1. Except as provided in subd. 2., the department may not encumber or  
15 expend any state funds from any appropriation to the department under s. 20.395  
16 for the costs of fabrication, erection, maintenance, or replacement of markers

21 this purpose.

22           3. The department may not encumber or expend any federal funds from any  
23 appropriation to the department under s. 20.395 for the costs of fabrication, erection,  
24 maintenance, or replacement of markers identified in par. (a) except federal funds

1 expressly allocated by federal law or by the applicable federal agency for the markers  
2 identified in par. (a).”.

3 **6.** Page 5, line 3: after that line insert:

4 **“SECTION 6m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

5 (1) The department of transportation shall determine the dollar amount  
6 necessary to fabricate and erect the signs required under section 84.10255 of the  
7 statutes, as created by this act, and report the amount to the department of tourism.

8 (2) From the appropriation under section 20.380 (1) (b) of the statutes, the  
9 department of tourism shall provide to the department of transportation an amount  
10 equal to the amount determined in subsection (1), but not to exceed \$50,000.”.
