Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Using readily available data, it is estimated the state fiscal effect of a waiver of the application fee to a Wisconsin technical college during the second full week of October is \$189,358 per year.

Wisconsin Technical College System programs have open enrollment (i.e., enrollment throughout the year until the program is filled. Students must submit a non-refundable application fee of \$30 to each technical college to which the student is applying.

The latest data available from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, indicates that in 2013-14, 20.7 percent or 12,623 of high school graduates reported their post-graduation plans were to attend a vocational/technical college.

For the purpose of this fiscal estimate, it is assumed that half of the 12,623 planning to attend a vocational/technical college or 6,312 high school seniors would choose to submit their applications during the second full week of October in order to take advantage of the application fee waiver. It is further assumed that students apply to only one of the sixteen technical colleges and do not apply to multiple technical colleges. The cost of the application waiver to the State of Wisconsin is estimated at \$189,358 (i.e., \$30 application fee x 6,312 applications).

Because the legislation proposes that the appropriation would be a sum-sufficient, with the State of Wisconsin reimbursing a Wisconsin technical college for the cost of the application, there is no net cost to the sixteen Wisconsin technical colleges.
