2015 SENATE BILL 399

November 20, 2015 – Introduced by Senator L. Taylor, cosponsored by Representatives Goyke, Berceau, Bowen, Kessler and C. Taylor. Referred to Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety.

1 AN ACT to create 175.53 of the statutes; relating to: prohibiting certain law enforcement practices or policies.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a law enforcement agency from establishing a policy or engaging in a practice of enforcing laws in a manner that is intended primarily to raise revenue.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 175.53 of the statutes is created to read:

175.53 Prohibited policy or practice; law enforcement. No law enforcement agency, as defined in s. 165.83 (1) (b), may establish a policy or engage in a practice of enforcing civil, traffic, or criminal laws in a manner that is intended primarily to raise revenue for the agency, the state, or a political subdivision, as defined in s. 175.46 (1) (e).
