**2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 479**

November 4, 2015 - Introduced by Representatives KOLSTE, JORGENSEN, BERCEAU, MILROY and C. TAYLOR. Referred to Committee on Campaigns and Elections.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 230.40 (2) and 230.40 (5) of the statutes; **relating to:** the  
2 requirement that a classified service employee take a leave of absence to run  
3 for office.

---

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill removes the requirement that a person employed in the classified service who runs for a partisan political office take a leave of absence during the campaign period for that office. The bill maintains the requirement under current law that the person separate from the classified service if elected.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

4 **SECTION 1.** 230.40 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:  
5 230.40 (2) If a person in the classified service declares an intention to run for  
6 partisan political office the person shall be placed on a leave of absence for the  
7 duration of the election campaign and if is elected to a partisan political office, that

1 person shall separate from the classified service on assuming the duties and  
2 responsibilities of such office.

3 **SECTION 2.** 230.40 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 230.40 (5) Persons on leave from the classified service under ~~subs. (2) and sub.~~  
5 (4) shall not be subject to the restrictions of sub. (1), except as they apply to the  
6 solicitation of assistance, subscription, or support from any person holding any  
7 position in the classified service.
