Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Burial costs are reimbursed under the federal plot allowance program through the Federal VA and therefore have no fiscal effect for the Department or the State.

Based on burial costs provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs, Bureau of Cemeteries and Memorial Services, the costs reimbursed for an Urn Garden burial is \$336 and for a Columbarium burial is \$206.
