Hi, Mark -

I will need the following amendment of SB 519 for introduction tomorrow afternoon:

Increase the dollar amounts for the appropriation to a total of \$10 million in each year of the biennium.

Transfer from the general fund to the universal service fund \$5 million in each year of the biennium.

In evaluating grant proposals, the PSC must prioritize first those areas of the state with the lowest broadband coverage and the highest unemployment rates.

No later than August 1, 2016, the public service commission shall submit a report to the joint committee on finance on federal broadband expansion funding opportunities.



SECTION 1c. 196.504 (2) (c) of the statutes, as affected by 2015 Wisconsin Act 55, is amended to read:

196.504 (2) (c) To establish criteria for evaluating applications and awarding grants under this section. The criteria shall prohibit grants that have the effect of subsidizing the expenses of a telecommunication provider or the monthly bills of telecommunications customers. The criteria shall give priority to projects that include matching funds, that involve public-private partnerships, that affect areas with no broadband service providers, that are scalable, that are located in counties with the highest unemployment rates in the state, that are located in counties with the lowest rates of broadband access in the state, or that affect a large geographic

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1	area or a large number of underserved individuals or communities. The criteria shall
