Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under Senate Bill 536, it permits DWD to request DOJ to assist DWD in the investigation of a false or fraudulent activity on the part of an employer, employee, insurer, health care provider or other person related to worker's compensation. This bill further requires that if DWD believes that a theft, forgery, fraud or other criminal activity has occurred, DWD must refer that matter to the DA or DOJ for prosecution. DOJ does not have information on how many how many cases may be referred to DOJ for investigation and prosecution. However, DWD has indicated that the increase will require new FTE based on their analysis of anticipated case workload.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
