**SENATE AMENDMENT ,
TO SENATE BILL 536**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 13, line 20: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 20m. 102.07 (6) of the statutes is repealed.”

4 **2.** Page 31, line 4: after that line insert:

5 “SECTION 53m. 102.31 (1) (c) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

6 102.31 (1) (c) 2. An intermediate agency or publisher referred to in s. 102.07

7 (6) of a newspaper or magazine may, under its own contract of insurance, cover

8 liability of employees as defined in s. 102.07 (6) persons selling or distributing the

9 newspaper or magazine on the street or from house to house for an intermediate or

10 independent news agency, if the contract of insurance of the publisher or

11 intermediate agency is endorsed to cover those persons. If the publisher so covers,

for whom the person sells or distributes

1 the intermediate or independent news agency need not cover liability for those
2 persons.”.

5 102.60 (7) This section does not apply to an employee, as defined in s. 102.07

6 (6), a person selling or distributing newspapers or magazines on the street or from

7 house to house if the agency or publisher of the newspaper or magazine establishes

8 by affirmative proof that at the time of the injury the employee person was not

9 employed with the actual or constructive knowledge of the agency or publisher.”.
