ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT,
ASSEMBLY **TO ASSEMBLY BILL 699** *597*

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 2: after “13” insert “and providing a penalty”.

3 **2.** Page 2, line 4: delete the material beginning with “that” and ending with
4 “guard” on line 5.

5 **3.** Page 2, line 7: after that line insert:

6 “SECTION 2. 30.80 (2c) of the statutes is created to read:

7 30.80 (2c) Any person violating s. 30.68 (1) shall forfeit not more than \$50 for
8 a first violation and not more than \$100 for a 2nd or subsequent violation.

9 SECTION 3. 30.80 (2m) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 30.80 (2m) Any person violating s. 30.678 or 30.68 (2) to (12) shall be required
11 to obtain a certificate of satisfactory completion of a safety course under s. 30.74 (1).

12 If the person has a valid certificate at the time that the court imposes sentence under

1 sub. (1) or (2), the court shall permanently revoke the certificate and order the person
2 to obtain a certificate of satisfactory completion of a safety course under s. 30.74 (1).”
