1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 3, line 20: after that line insert:

3 “(d) By July 1, 2018, submit to the appropriate standing committees of the  
4 legislature under s. 13.172 (3) and to the joint committee on finance a report in which  
5 the state superintendent makes a recommendation as to whether to continue the  
6 pilot program under this subsection. The state superintendent shall consider, at a  
7 minimum, the following factors when making his or her recommendation:

- 8 1. The number of schools and pupils that participated in the program.
- 9 2. The number of businesses and other private entities involved in the program.
- 10 3. The adequacy of the funding provided to the program for sustaining the
- 11 program.”.
