The Second Chance bill – allow DWD and others to market opportunities to former UW students who are no longer attending school.

Why:

A professional organization, representing an industry sector, mentioned to us how they do have entry level openings in their industry, that pay well and can lead to excellent careers, but they can't find enough applicants who can meet a few basic requirements:

- Read/write at an acceptable level
- Have a valid driver's license
- Pass a drug test.

They noted that college students can generally meet all these requirements, and they would love to market their opportunities directly to former students who have decided a 4-year degree isn't for them.

So we would like a bill to do the following:

UW schools will keep track of the students who were going to the school last semester, but not this semester, and who have not graduated.

DWD will prepare information about other opportunities, including educational opportunities (tech colleges, apprenticeships, etc.), direct work opportunities, where to find additional information about a next step, etc.

- This can be done on a regional or local basis if DWD has information specific to specific areas.
- DWD may accept or incorporate materials from private organizations.

DWD will prepare this information for mailing and give it to each UW school. The UW school will send it to the former students.

DWD pays for the materials and postage, but UW keeps control of the lists of students for privacy reasons. So DWD will pay for everything except getting the addresses on the envelopes and putting them in the mail.

Not sure what fund to use – DWD thinks they may have money already available for it. We can leave that open for now.

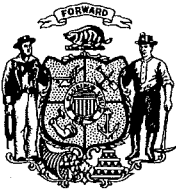

This bill requires the Department of Workforce Development to 1) prepare a packet of information describing the employment and training opportunities that are available to former students of the universities and two-year college campuses within the University of Wisconsin System who have not graduated from a university or college campus within the UW System and 2) within two months after the beginning of each semester or session of the UW System, send a copy of the packet to each individual who was enrolled in a university or college campus within the UW System in the preceding semester, but who is not enrolled in, and who has not graduated from, any university or college campus within the UW System.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. 20.445 (1) (ga) of the statutes is amended to read:

1 20.445 (1) (ga) *Auxiliary services*. All moneys received from fees collected
2 under ss. 102.16 (2m) (d), 103.005 (15) ~~and~~, 106.09 (7), and 106.20 (3) for the delivery
3 of services under ss. 102.16 (2m) (f), 103.005 (15) ~~and~~, 106.09, and 106.20 (3) and ch.
4 108.

5 **SECTION 2.** 106.20 of the statutes is created to read:

6 **106.20 Marketing of opportunities to former University of Wisconsin**
7 **System students.** (1) The department shall prepare a packet of information
8 describing the employment and training opportunities that are available to former
9 students of the institutions and college campuses within the University of Wisconsin
10 System who have not graduated from an institution or college campus within that
11 system and advising those former students how to obtain additional information
12 about those opportunities. The packet may describe those opportunities on a
13 regional or local basis, if the department has information about those opportunities
14 that is specific to the regional or local areas of this state, and may include or reference
15 materials about those opportunities that have been prepared by a technical college,
16 by a private organization providing apprenticeship training, or by a private
17 organization providing training in collaboration with a technical college. The
18 department shall update the information contained in the packet before the
19 beginning of each semester or session of the University of Wisconsin System.

20 (2) (a) Subject to par. (b), within 2 months after the beginning of each semester
21 or session of the University of Wisconsin System, each institution or college campus
22 within the University of Wisconsin System shall compile and transmit to the
23 department a list of the names and addresses of all individuals who were enrolled
24 in the institution or college campus in the preceding semester, but who are not
25 enrolled in, and who have not graduated from, any institution or college campus

1 within that system, and the department shall send a copy of the packet of
2 information prepared under sub. (1) to each individual so listed.

3 (b) An institution or college campus within the University of Wisconsin System
4 may not include in the list compiled under par. (a) the name and address of any
5 individual who has informed the institution or college campus under 20 USC 1232g
6 (5) (B) that directory information about the individual may not be released without
7 the prior consent of the individual.

8 (3) The department shall fund the costs of printing and postage of the packet
9 of information prepared under sub. (1) from the appropriation accounts under s.
10 20.445 (1) (a) and (ga). If the department includes in the packet of information
11 prepared under sub. (1) materials that have been prepared by a private organization,
12 the department may charge the private organization for the cost of printing, and the
13 proportionate cost of posting, those materials.

14 **SECTION 3. Initial applicability.**

15 (1) **MARKETING OF OPPORTUNITIES TO FORMER UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN SYSTEM**
16 **STUDENTS.** This act first applies beginning with the first semester or session following
17 the effective date of this subsection.
