Senator Larson would like to request the following amendments to **Senate Bill 432**. Please let me know if you have questions or if there is someone else I should forward this draft request to.

- 1. A substitute amendment that prohibits ALL future sales of water utilities to private firms. (Wisconsin municipal to Wisconsin municipal would still be okay)
- 2. Prohibit the sale of water utilities to out-of-state private firms. (Would allow in-state private firms)
- 3. Prohibit the sale of water utilities to private firms that have out-of-country ownership.
- 4. Require financial transparency of any private company that buys municipal water.
- 5. Require immediate disclosure of any Wisconsin political donations or political expenditures by private water firms seeking to purchase water utilities or provide water services.
- 6. Require immediate disclosure of any Wisconsin political donations or political expenditures by owners or employees of private water firms seeking to purchase water utilities or provide water services.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits a town, village, or city from selling or leasing to an investor-owned public utility any plant or portion of a plant used to provide water or sewer service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 Section 1. 66.0817 (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 \times 66.0817 Sale or lease of municipal public utility plant. (intro.) A Except
- 5 <u>as provided in sub. (8), a</u> town, village or city may sell or lease any complete public
- 6 utility plant owned by it in the following manner:
