Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill increases the amount of GPR funding administered by DCF for Community Action Agencies, Skills Enhancement grants by \$250,000 in each year of the current biennium (with the act taking effect retroactively to July 1, 2015). Therefore, the fiscal effect is \$250,000 annually, totalling \$500,000 for the current biennium.
