




AN ACT to amend 66.0501 (2); and to create 8.21 (2) (bg) and 8.21 (2) (br) of the

statutes; relating to: eligibility of a candidate for elective office.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits an individual from holding an elective national, state, or local office while running for a different elective national, state, or local office, unless the term of the office that the individual holds expires before the term for the new office begins. The bill also prohibits an individual from being a candidate for two or more offices simultaneously.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 8.21 (2) (bg) of the statutes is created to read:

8.21 (2) (bg) 1. That, subject to subd. 2., the signer does not currently hold an elective national, state, or local office other than the office named under par. (a).

2. If the signer holds an elective office other than the office named under par.

(a), that the term of that office will expire before the candidate, if elected to the office named under par. (a), would take office.

Section 2. 8.21 (2) (br) of the statutes is created to read:

8.21 (2) (br) That the signer is not a candidate for any elective national, state, or local office other than the office named under par. (a).

Section 3. 66.0501 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.0501 (2) ELIGIBILITY OF OTHER OFFICERS. Except as expressly authorized by statute, no member of a town, village, or county board, or city council, during the term for which the member is elected, is eligible for any office or position which during that term has been created by, or the selection to which is vested in, the board or council, but the member is eligible for any elective office. The governing body may be represented on city, village, or town boards and commissions where no additional compensation, except a per diem, is paid to the representatives of the governing body and may fix the tenure of these representatives notwithstanding any other statutory provision. A representative of a governing body who is a member of a city, village, or town board or commission may receive a per diem only if the remaining members of the board or commission may receive a per diem. This subsection does not apply to a member of any board or council described in this subsection who resigns from the board or council before being appointed to an office or position which was not created during the member's term in office.

SECTION 4. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to a declaration of candidacy filed on the effective date of this subsection.
