1 AN ACT to amend 66.0501 (2); and to create 8.21 (2) (bg) and 8.21 (2) (br) of the
2 statutes; relating to: eligibility of a candidate for elective office.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits an individual from holding an elective national, state, or local office while running for a different elective national, state, or local office, unless the term of the office that the individual holds expires before the term for the new office begins. The bill also prohibits an individual from being a candidate for two or more offices simultaneously.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 8.21 (2) (bg) of the statutes is created to read:
4 8.21 (2) (bg) 1. That, subject to subd. 2., the signer does not currently hold an
5 elective national, state, or local office other than the office named under par. (a).
6 2. If the signer holds an elective office other than the office named under par.
7 (a), that the term of that office will expire before the candidate, if elected to the office
8 named under par. (a), would take office.
