Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

According to the Division Administrators and the Budget Director, this legislation will have a fiscal impact on DSPS. There will be one-time costs associated with 1) researching, drafting, and processing administrative rules related to this new credential; 2) providing liaison and administrative services to the new board; 3) creating the new credential in the Integrated Credentialing and Enforcement (ICE) System database; 4) making changes to the Online License Application System (OLAS) and the Online Verification System (OLVS); 5) creating new and renewal procedures and training for staff; 6) developing web pages and application forms; and 7) adding requirements and rules into the enforcement module within ICE. There will also be ongoing costs related to providing liaison and administrative services to the board; processing new and renewal applications; processing and investigating complaints against licensees, prosecuting licensees, and monitoring disciplined licensees.

DSPS is not able to determine the fiscal effect on local governments.
