AN ACT ...; relating to: training requirements for a license to carry a concealed

weapon.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau Land

This bill requires that a person who applies to the Department of Justice for a license to carry a concealed weapon undergo at least six hours of training, one hour of which involves shooting range experience, and requires that each session train no more than 25 participants a time. Current law requires training for licensure but does not specify duration or class size and also prohibits DOJ from requiring that live ammunition be fired as part of the training requirement.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that a person who applies to the Department of Justice for a license to carry a concealed weapon undergo at least six hours of training, one hour of which involves shooting range experience and each session of which is limited to 25 participants. Current law requires training for licensure but does not specify duration or class size and also prohibits DOJ from requiring that live ammunition be fired as part of the training requirement.
