Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 780 increases the tipped employee minimum wage from \$2.33 to \$7.08 per hour through a series of annual increases of \$.95. Once this wage rate is reached, SB 780 eliminates the separate minimum wage altogether, subjecting tipped employees to the general minimum wage (currently \$7.25 per hour or \$5.90 an hour for opportunity employees).

Administratively, this legislation would create 300 wage complaints annually that cannot be absorbed at current staffing levels. To meet this increased workload, two Equal Rights Officers and one attorney would need to be hired at an added annual cost of \$230,000. Additional one-time costs of \$5 000 are also needed to update and reprint existing documentation relating to minimum wage laws.
