Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under this bill, anyone who believes that a railroad employee has improperly exercised police authority may file a complaint with the Department of Justice. Justified complaints are to be referred to the District Attorney.

It is uncertain how many complaints may be filed; however, prosecutors believe the number of such complaints will not be significant enough to have a fiscal impact on their offices.
