2015 SENATE RESOLUTION

Relating to: honoring the UW-Green Bay/Men's Basketball Team. Whereas, the UW-Green Bay/men's basketball team defeated Wright State 78-69 for the Horizon League tournament championship; and Whereas, the Phoenix also upset top-seeded Valparaiso during its first run to 5 the NCAA Tournament since 1996; and 6 Whereas, the Phoenix defense has generated 344 steals this season, which is tops in the nation, and they led the Horizon League with an average of 10 steals per game; and Whereas, the Phoenix offense had four players average in double figures in conference play, led by senior guard Carrington Love/at 17.8 points per game, and finished second in scoring offense by averaging 84.0 points per game; and 12 Whereas, senior Carrington Love was named to the All-Horizon League First 13 Team, senior Jordan Fouse was awarded Second Team honors, and both players were 14 also named to the All-Defensive Team, with Fouse becoming just the second player

1 in conference history to be selected to the Horizon League All-Defensive team 2 four-consecutive years; and 3 Whereas, a team picked to finish sixth in the Horizon League has more than 4 exceeded expectations under new head coach Linc Darner by finishing fourth in conference play by posting an impressive 11-3 mark at the Resch Center and 5 6 surpassing the 20-win mark for the third-straight season; and 7 Whereas, Coach Darner told his players during their first meeting last April 8 that they would make it to the NCAA Tournament this season, and they responded 9 by earning a spot for the fifth time in program history; now, therefore, be it Resolved by the senate, That the members of the Wisconsin Senate hereby 10 commend and congratulate the UW-Green Bay Men's Basketball Team on a 11 successful regular season and wishes them the best of luck in the NCAA tournament; 13 and, be it further **Resolved**, That the senate chief clerk shall provide copies of this resolution to Head Coach Linc Darner, his staff, each member of the team, and Athletic Director 16 Mary Ellen Gillespie.
