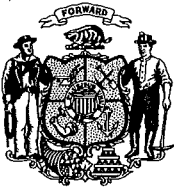

Relating to: honoring the UW-Green Bay Men's Basketball Team.

Whereas, the UW-Green Bay men's basketball team defeated Wright State 78-69 for the Horizon League tournament championship; and

Whereas, the Phoenix also upset top-seeded Valparaiso during its first run to the NCAA Tournament since 1996; and

Whereas, the Phoenix defense has generated 344 steals this season, which is tops in the nation, and they led the Horizon League with an average of 10 steals per game; and

Whereas, the Phoenix offense had four players average in double figures in conference play, led by senior guard Carrington Love at 17.8 points per game, and finished second in scoring offense by averaging 84.0 points per game; and

Whereas, senior Carrington Love was named to the All-Horizon League First Team, senior Jordan Fouse was awarded Second Team honors, and both players were also named to the All-Defensive Team, with Fouse becoming just the second player
