85.22 Capital assistance program for specialized transportation

DESCRIPTION OF CHANGE:

All sections: We are requesting that the word "capital" be removed from the language because going forward other project types are also eligible for funding. The federal language has changed the word "elderly" to "senior" and we request that change be made throughout.

<u>Section 1</u>: Removing the word "capital" and changing "elderly" to "senior" are the only requested changes.

Section 2:

- Section (am): The definition of eligible applicant in the federal language is different depending on the type of project that is being applied for. We suggest removing the specific definition and referencing the federal language for eligible applicants.
- Section (b): Change "elderly" to "senior" and the age from 55 to 65 as stated in the federal language.

Section 3:

- Section (a): Remove the word "annually" in reference to the application cycle. We would like the flexibility of running the competitive application cycle on a two-year basis.
- Section (c): Change "elderly" to "senior".
- Section (g): Remove the word "annual" from the application cycle to allow the flexibility of running the competitive application cycle on a two-year basis.
- Section (h): Change "elderly" to "senior" and remove the reference to section 2.b. as we are recommending that section be eliminated.

Section 4:

- Section (a): Sentence 1 be rewritten to "Commencing with the highest ranked application and to the extent that state <u>and federal</u> moneys are available, the department shall offer to each eligible applicant an amount of state <u>and / or federal</u> aid such that the sum of federal and state aid received by an applicant does not exceed <u>the funding limitations defined in 49 USC 5310</u>. The first two additions allow for flexibility in using federal and state funds. The final change is requested because various project types can have different funding limitations in the new 5310 program.
- Section (a): Remove the remainder of the language in sections 1., 2., and 2(b), where we recommend that the reference to the 49 USC 5310 language be used.

JUSTIFICATION:

Under s. 85.22, Wis. Stats., WisDOT administers a competitive grant program to award a combination of state funds and federal (49 U.S.C. 5310 – Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities program) funds for provision of transportation service to the State's senior and disabled residents.

Historically federal 5310 funds were limited to use on capital projects and s. 85.22 was constructed consistent with the original federal program. New federal legislation (MAP-21) now allows projects that were previously eligible under Section 5317 (New Freedom), including operating projects, to be eligible under this expanded Section 5310 program.

With these recent rule changes, the current construction of the statute threatens to constrain the Department's ability to optimally administer the Section 5310 program and especially its ability to fully fund the types of projects previously funded under the New Freedom program. A handful of simple changes in statutory text could remedy this by enabling the use of state funds for the full range of purposes permitted under Section 5310.

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) administers an elderly and disabled transportation capital assistance program. Under the program, DOT annually awards grants to qualified private, nonprofit organizations and local public bodies for capital costs related to specialized vehicles and facilities used to provide transportation services to elderly and disabled persons.

This bill changes several of the requirements of the program. Among these: 1) the program is not limited to capital costs 2) the assistance beneficiary category of elderly persons, defined as persons age 55 or older, is changed to seniors, defined as age 65 or older 3) DOT is not required to maintain an annual application cycle and 4) several statutory requirements that are in addition to federal requirements related to applicants and award amounts are eliminated.
