

Under the existing broadband expansion grant program, PSC makes broadband expansion grants to eligible applicants for the purpose of constructing broadband infrastructure in underserved areas designated by PSC. Currently, the appropriation for this program is a continuing appropriation. Under this bill, the appropriation for the program will be a biennial appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

1 196.504. The amounts transferred from s. 20.505 (1) (is) to this appropriation shall
2 be credited to this appropriation account.
