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

Under current law, money is appropriated to DNR annually for grants related to forest fire suppression and prevention. Also under current law, money is appropriated to DNR biennially for grant programs related to forest management and urban forestry projects. This bill changes these annual and biennial appropriations to continuing appropriations, which are expendable until fully depleted or repealed by subsequent action of the legislature.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
